On March 22, 2018 ABIF, the Trainers' Academy (REFAK), the Austrian Union Federation for Private Employees and the Public Employment Service Austria held a conference with the title „Quality ist not achieved by chance – Quality in Training Organisations: Learning from Pracial Experiences”.
